Eligibility and Competition Rules

Applications must be postmarked or submitted online by March 15, 2017

All Competitions are open to a public audience.

Solo Competition *(applications must be postmarked by Wednesday, March 15, 2017 or submitted online through our website by 11:59 pm, March 15, 2017)*

- Flutists compete in one of eleven categories based on age. (categories listed on application).
- Flutists may compete on any instrument in the flute family (flute, piccolo, alto, etc.) in their age category.
- Flutists may perform more than one solo in the competition but it must be on a different instrument in the flute family.
- Solos should be appropriate to the skill level.
- Competitors **must provide their own accompanist** unless the work is written for flute alone.

Ensemble Competition *(applications must be postmarked by Wednesday, March 15, 2017 or submitted online by 11:59 pm, March 15, 2017)*

- Ensembles must contain at least one member of the flute family (flute, piccolo, alto, etc.), but may consist of any instrumentation and any size group of two or more.
- Ensembles will perform in one of three categories according to the age of the oldest member. (categories listed on application)
- Music should be appropriate to skill level and must be performed on the instruments specified in the score.

Awards

- First Place and Honorable Mentions will be selected in each category and will be announced at the end of the day.
- At the recommendation of the judges, the Houston Flute Club reserves the right to not select a winner in a category.
- All judges' decisions are final.
- First Place winners will be invited to perform in the Honors Recital on Sunday, May 21, 2017 at Memorial Drive UMC.

Competitors must bring

- A legible copy of the music with numbered measures to be submitted to the judge.
- Their Instrument(s) and music, and a music stand (especially for large ensembles in warm-up rooms).
- Performers may bring recording equipment to record their performance and comments from the judges but it is not required.

Fees and HFC membership requirements

- Solo fees are \$25 per entry.
- Ensemble fees are \$5 per competitor, \$25 max. (Ensembles with more than 5 competitors pay only \$25).
- No refunds will be offered after an application has been submitted.
- Elementary, Junior High, Senior High, and Undergraduate student competitors must be a student of a current member of the HFC or be a current student member.
- Graduate Students and Adult competitors **MUST** be a current member of the Houston Flute Club for the Solo Competition and at least one member of the ensemble must be a member for the Adult Ensemble Competition.
- **All teachers with students in the competition who are entered in the Undergraduate grade category or lower are REQUIRED to help with Flute Fest.**

Competitor Schedule

- Flutists will be assigned a performance time approximately between 9:00am and 3:30pm.
- **List conflicts** on your application form. HFC will make every attempt to accommodate your conflicts.
- **No** changes will be made **after Saturday, April 8, 2017.**
- If possible, teachers should collect all student forms and mail or submit them online together.
- Competitors' times will be sent directly to the teachers **ONLY** by Saturday, April 8, 2017. Current HFC members will have access to view the competition schedule on our website through a secured member-only log-in.
